

The project « The family in the United Europe» was funded with the support of the European Union under the Programme "Europe for Citizens"

Participation: The project involved 49 citizens, notably 10 participants from the city of Tarnowo Podgórne (**Poland**), 23 participants from the city of Livani (**Latvia**), 4 participants from the city of Salcininkai (**Lithuania**), 3 participants from the city of Cologno al Serio (**Italy**), 5 participants from the city of Ukmerge (**Lithuania**), 5 participants from the city of Bardo (**Poland**), 4 participants from the city of Kamieniec Podolski (**Ukraine**)

Location/ Dates: The event took place in Tarnowo Podgórne, Poznań, from 04/07/2014r. to 06/07/2014

Short description:

The day of 04/07/2014 was dedicated to the conference entitled "Modern Family - ideals, problems, challenges"

During the conference was held a lecture entitled: "The family regulations of EU," which was led by dr Iwetta Andruszkiewicz. In addition the conference's participants had the opportunity to present good practice relating to the supporting activities in the area of the family support implemented in their communities. The conference ended with a debate led by dr Iwetta Andruszkiewicz. The conference was also attended by Deputy Waldy Dzikowski

The day of **05/07/2014** was dedicated to the Family Car Rally and family fest.

The car rally was attended by 40 teams from the area of family Tarnowo Podgórne (115 participants) and 6 teams from the partner municipalities (including guardians). The winner was the crew from Leszno, Second and third place went to the team from Mosina. Among the crews composed of representatives of the partner municipalities, first and second place was taken by the crew of Livani and third prize went to the crew of Cologno al Serio. The participants of the rally were guaranteed parking places that is why the majority of them took part in the family fest which was held in the open air. The event was attended by approximately 10 thousand of people from Tarnowo Podgórne and surrounding municipalities.

The day of **06/07/2014** was dedicated to the summary of the project, in which representatives of partner communities along with representatives of Tarnowo Podgórne Municipality talked about the project and discussed the possibility of joint projects in the future.
